

URGENT PRESS ENQUIRY RE: Allegations regarding Mohammad Al-Mail

Hi

I'm writing about a number of allegations of anti-Semitic hate speech levelled against one of your members/associates, Mohammad Al-Mail, which I was hoping to put to him in order to have his side of the article.

I'd be grateful if Mr Al-Mail could respond to reports that he was not charged for terrorism offences after videos apparently showed him saying "I love the 7th of October" and "I like an organisation that starts with H" at an anti-Israel protest in London in September 2024.

On an Arabic-language podcast named 'The High Hand Authority', Mr Al-Mail appeared to boast that he avoided prosecution, despite two referrals to the CPS by the Metropolitan Police, by saying the 'H' referred to the Home Office.

In the same podcast he said: "Not every day is like October 7. If an opportunity arises, we must fully exploit it. If you strike, make it hurt."

Mr Al-Mail has also avoided prosecution for his campaign group's promotion of Jihadist causes. Having gained asylum after being sentenced for 53 years in prison for defaming the Emir of Kuwait and insulting his country's monarchy, Mr Al-Mail has distributed leaflets and stickers at protests. Some of them say 'a new Khaybar awaits', a phrase interpreted as designed to incite violence against Jews.

I'd be grateful if Mr Al-Mail could address the above allegations and send me a response in order for me to write a fair and balanced report regarding his activities as an activist.

I'd be grateful if I could have these by 6pm tomorrow (Thursday).
