Thank you for your correspondence of 5 December about human rights in Kuwait.

We are sorry to hear about your circumstances and the concerns raised in your correspondence. The UK remains committed to upholding international law and promoting human rights globally, including in Kuwait, where our close and longstanding relationship enables open dialogue across a range of issues, including on human rights. Officials from the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office have discussed the implications of Kuwait's denationalisation campaign with the Kuwaiti authorities on multiple occasions. We do not comment on individual cases.

The UK takes the protection of individuals' rights, freedoms, and safety very seriously. If you ever feel in any immediate danger, you should reach out to the police immediately.
