I never supported Oslo as it was a neo-colonial 'solution' whereby the Palestinians did Israel's dirty work. The settlements arise from settler colonialism not secularism indeed the settlers are mainly messianic madmen.

You say the imperialists never feared the left. Not true. The United States and the CIA backed Khomeini against the left in Iran.

If Israeli soldiers shouted in 1967, "The religion of Muhammad has gone and passed," it was not because they feared Islam but because they too, just like you see the struggle in religious terms. You are merely their pathetic echo chamber seeking to sow divisions in the struggle of the Palestinians which you have never supported because, like ISIS, you saw it as an Islamic struggle.
